

**'Floods and water-level changes of the Middle Danube since the 13th century
and its impacts' by Andrea Kiss**

Developed based on original, contemporary documentary and partly archaeological evidence, the current stage of the 800-year long flood reconstruction and possible long-term water-level changes of the Middle Danube are discussed in the presentation, with identifying flood-rich periods and some outstanding great floods since the beginning of the 13th century. Applying (late) medieval, 16th- and 18th-century case studies, in the second part of the presentation major consequences, socio-economic impacts and social response (resilience, mitigation, prevention) of Danube floods in the central and western part of the Carpathian Basin are analysed in more detail.
